# Moorings

A note from the secretary: One of our members checked his mooring recently and found that the chain links were badly worn. So, this is a quick reminder that if you have not checked your mooring chains, warps and connections for wear and chafe in the last twelve months then you should do so. The fine silt in the local waters has an abrasive action on your mooring tackle. Going out onto the mud is dangerous. Never go out onto the mud alone and always carry a means of calling for help. If you are not happy going out onto the mud then employ a professional to check your mooring for you. ACBOC also requires mooring holders to have insurance for their boat with 3rd party as a minimum.
